



## How to Watch Caregiver Brief Online Trainings

- ① Go to [triad.vkclearning.org](http://triad.vkclearning.org)
- ② Create an account by clicking on “[Register](#).” You will create a username and password. Fill out the form and select “[TRIAD](#)” under the doorway. You will receive an email verification. Once you do, click the link to verify your account and log in.
- ③ Click on “[Caregivers](#)” to access the Caregiver Training Modules or on another category to access other BOTS.
- ④ Click “open” for the series you would like to watch.
- ⑤ Click “launch” for the training you want to watch and enjoy!
