

## Rhythm and Timing in Autism

### Eligibility

- Between 18 and 50 years old
- Fluent native English speaker
- No current speech, hearing, or non-correct visual impairments
- Both autistic and nonautistic adults are eligible!

- Play some rhythm and tapping games
- Watch some movies
- Do some short tests of your thinking and cognition
- Fill out some surveys about yourself and your musical engagement
