

Baby Sibling and Autism Study

Would you like to learn about your baby's language and social development?

We invite babies 6-12 months old to join our study on social and language development. Babies are eligible if they have an older sibling with or without autism.

Families come to Vanderbilt for multiple study visits between 9 and 36 months of age. At the visits, babies play games that test language and social skills, watch a short movie, and complete play sessions with a parent. Parents complete study questionnaires.

Families receive information on their child's development, including developmental testing and assessments for autism, as well as a written report with results, recommendations, and referrals at no cost. Families are compensated for their time and participation.
