



Are you an adult who is seeking autism testing?

We are evaluating a new tool for autism assessment in adults. We want to see if this tool works. We are looking for participants who have been told they may have autism and who want to be tested.

You may be eligible if you are:

- Age 18 to 65 years
- Can have spoken conversations in English and answer questions about yourself without help
- Can consent for yourself and attend in-person study visits on your own
- Have been told by a doctor, therapist, or other professional that you should be tested for autism, and/or
- Are actively seeking autism testing for yourself

You may not be eligible if you have already had autism testing. Procedures are for research purposes.

What participation involves:

- Completing online forms before your first appointment (up to 30 minutes).
- Visit 1: Attending one telehealth visit where you will do some online activities and speak to a psychologist on Zoom (up to 120 minutes).
- Visit 2: Attending one in-person visit at VUMC where a psychologist will ask you questions and administer IQ and autism tests and give you feedback.
- Completing an online survey about your experience following both visits (up to 20 minutes each).

You will receive a \$100 gift card following Visit 2.
