Is your daughter or son with disabilities interested in finding paid employment?

Would you like guidance and support connecting them to a good job?

The **Tennessee Employment Pathways Project** is helping parents learn how to connect their family members with intellectual and developmental disabilities to paid employment.

What does it involve?

- Attend our “short course” focused on practical steps you can take to connect your family member to paid employment (5 sessions, 6 hours total)
- Receive check-ins from the project team every other month for a year
- Some—but not all—parents will also be matched with an informal mentor who helped their own family member find paid work

Parents will receive \$250 for completing the “short course” and all project measures.

To participate, you must:

- Live in Middle Tennessee
- Have a family member with intellectual disability or autism who is interested in working and has already exited high school (or will graduate this spring)
- Be at least 18 years old
