



Research Opportunity for Girls and Women with Rett Syndrome

The purpose of this study is to assess a clinician-reported assessment method called the Revised-Motor Behavior Assessment (R-MBA)

Participants will schedule an appointment to receive an on-site clinical evaluation by a member of the Vanderbilt Rett Syndrome Program clinical team. The evaluation will be videotaped for clinician review and may be used to create future educational materials.
