

Reading Tutoring at No Cost

Vanderbilt's Child Language and Literacy Lab is looking for children with speech difficulties to participate in a virtual reading tutoring study.

We are looking for children who are:

repeating kindergarten or in first or second grade, struggling to read, have trouble with their speech (e.g., have a speech or articulation disorder or have trouble saying certain sounds), English speaking

In this study, your child will:

- Receive virtual reading tutoring
- Complete speech, language, and reading tasks
- Learn to read fun stories

Compensation: Children will be compensated up to \$25 for completing initial testing session. Children found eligible after testing will be compensated up to \$5 per week of tutoring, plus a completion bonus up to \$25 for participating in tutoring until end of study.
