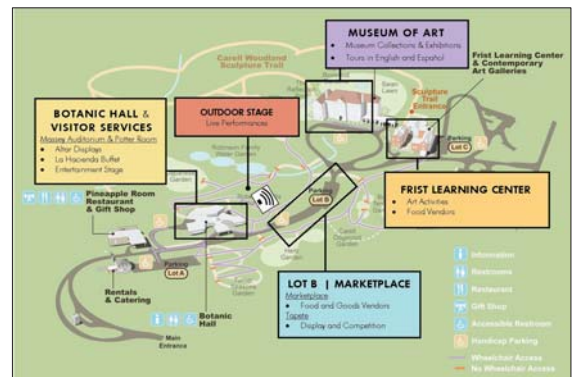
I am going to Cheekwood for the Día de los Muertos festival on November 1st. There will be many activities for me to do at the festival.

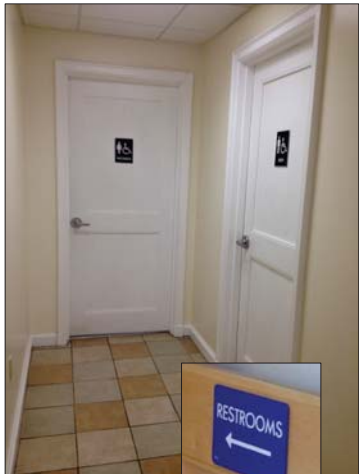
There will be music and dancing. Some people might be dancing on stage. I can dance on the ground. Some people might be wearing costumes. They wear costumes to celebrate the festival.
