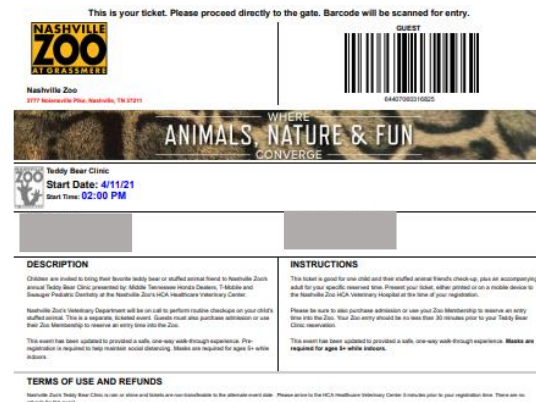


Going to the Teddy Bear Clinic Social Story

Inside the Teddy Bear Clinic, I will meet one of our veterinarians that takes care of the zoo animals.



The veterinarian will ask how I am and how my stuffed animal is feeling. They will perform an exam on my stuffed animal. The vet might use some vet tools like a stethoscope or put bandages on my stuffed animal.



I will get a certificate that says
