


Going to the Teddy Bear Clinic Social Story

Today I am bringing my stuffed animal to the Zoo for a check-up at the Teddy Bear Clinic.




I have a special ticket that tells my family what time my stuffed animal check-up is.

The veterinarian will ask how I am and how my stuffed animal is feeling. They will perform an exam on my stuffed animal. The vet might use some vet tools like a stethoscope or put bandages on my stuffed animal.



I will get a certificate that says my stuffed animal is healthy.



After my stuffed animal's vet visit, I can make a bear craft and take a picture with my family.
