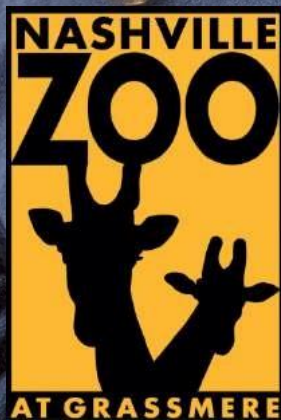

Animal Shows at the Zoo

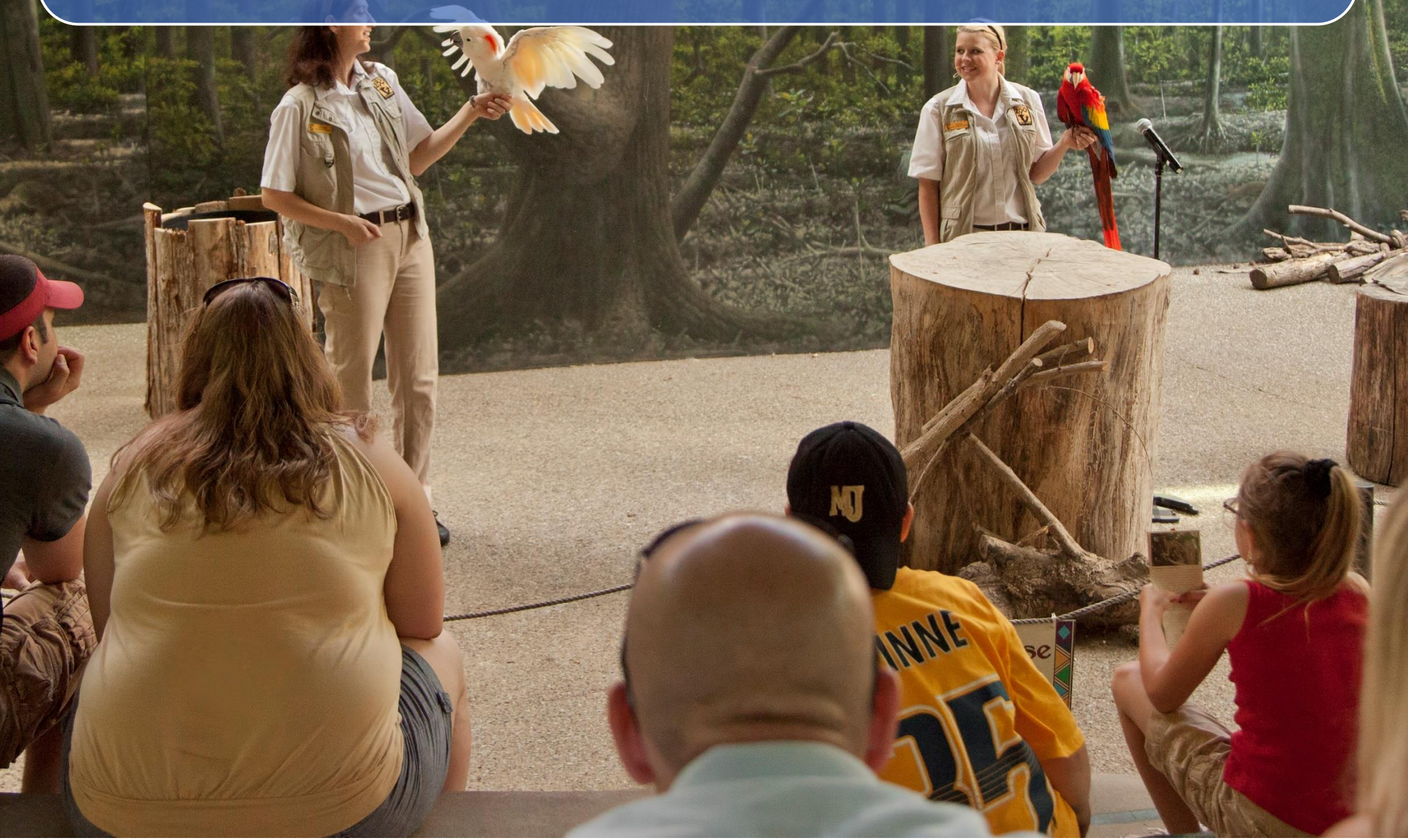
