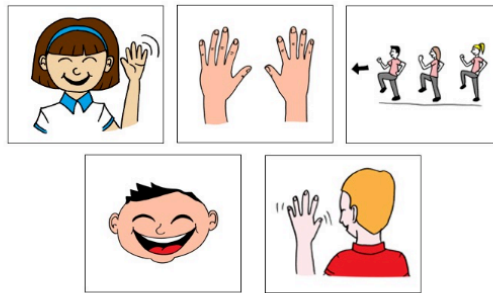
Video models, audio recordings, visual supports, and suggested strategies and tips for parent-child music activities at home.

The activities on the website come from the Serenade Parent-Child Music Class Program, a research-based music curriculum that provides parent training and peer interaction through musical play. Through these activities, parents and children build a musical toolbox of strategies for fostering shared experiences.

Each “Video Playlist” is ~15 minutes long and provides a mini music class set of song activities and suggested strategies for at-home music engagement. You can listen to a whole playlist or only select songs. You can also apply these strategies to your child’s favorite songs.
